

Student View via the Instructor Module

The Student View allows instructors to experience their course as a student. The Student View behaves as it would for a regular student – instructors can take the Initial Assessment, view their ALEKS Pie Chart, enter Learning Mode, and complete any assignments that have been created. The Student View also allows the instructor to skip the Initial Assessment, select a pre-determined knowledge state, and reset the Student View.

Note: The instructor's Student View is a virtual student account, meaning the student will not appear in the Gradebook or in any class reports.

Accessing the Student View

To access the Student View from the Basic or Advanced Instructor Module, select a class and then select the “Student View” link.



Navigating the Student View

After clicking on the “Student View” link, instructors will arrive at a summary of the Student View feature. Before working in the Student View, it is recommended that instructors create an assignment so they can experience taking an assignment as a student.

Instructors can reset the Student View by selecting the “Reset Student View” box. This will delete any previous work.

Before working in the Student View it is recommended you do the following:

- Create a homework assignment, quiz, or test so you can view it in the Student Interface

What you can do in the Student View:

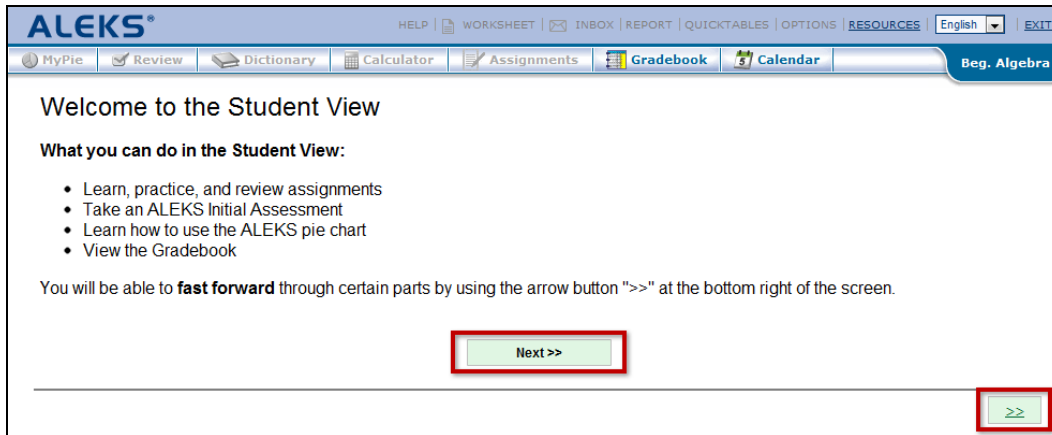
- See the tutorial and learn how to enter answers in mathematical notation

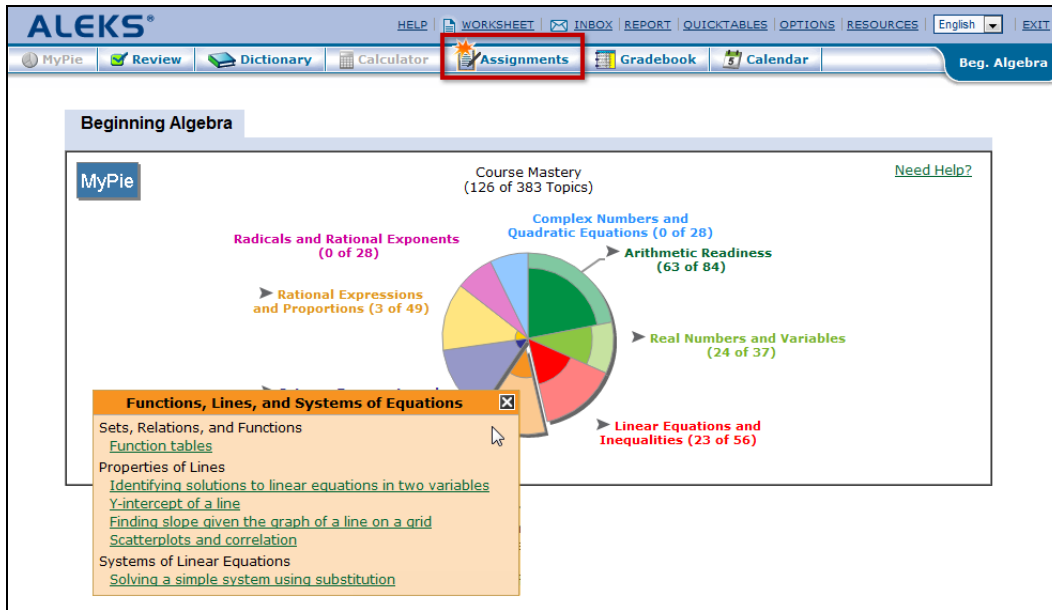
If this is the instructor's first time using the Student View, or if the Student View has been reset, the instructor will see a screen that describes the features of the Student View.

To enter the Student View, instructors can click on the "Next >>" button. To fast forward through certain parts of the tutorial or Initial Assessment, they can use the ">>" button.



Instructors can complete the Answer Editor Tutorial and the Initial Assessment or use the fast-forward button to skip these two features. Once they skip through, they can pick a pre-determined knowledge state. Either option will bring instructors to their ALEKS Pie Chart where they can access their Ready to Learn Topics.

If assignments have been created and assigned to the class, instructors can access them by selecting the "Assignments" button.



To logout of the Student View, instructors can select the "Exit" link. The next time instructors access their Student View account for the selected class, they will return to the screen they last visited. If the instructor chooses to reset the Student View, they will return to the start of the Answer Editor Tutorial and Initial Assessment.
